I took a 5 week course about the "Blue Zones."

- "'The goal of studying the five Blue Zones was to uncover commonalities that might explain why people from these regions live longer lives and without the chronic disease rates we see elsewhere,' explains McAfee. Buettner's team identified nine healthy principles called the Power 9 they believe to be at the core of Blue Zone living:
 - 1. Making movement a natural part of your day
 - 2. Knowing your sense of purpose
 - 3. Prioritizing stress relief
 - 4. Eating until you're about 80% full
 - 5. Eating a largely plant-based diet
 - 6. Drinking alcohol in moderation
 - 7. Connecting with your community
 - 8. Putting family (whether biological or chosen) first
 - Choosing social circles that support healthy behavior"
